- Development/fundraising experience preferred but not required.
- At least two years of management experience preferred but not required.
- Experience in a field with either extensive customer service or comparable emotional demands, challenging situations or sad outcomes.
- Ability to be impartial, effectively manage and assist diverse personalities. "We listen, we don't judge".
- Live in the greater Las Vegas area.
- Valid NV Driver's license or ability to obtain one soon after employment.

Physical Requirements

Physical ability to walk and/or stand on your feet throughout a normal workday.

- While you'll be seated for most of the time, be ready to lift and move objects up to 20 pounds, and bend
 or stand when needed.
- If you have allergies that flare up around animals, this might not be the right fit for you.

<u>Nature of Employment:</u> The Development Manager will receive direction and have oversight from the Executive Director. This position will be performed onsite at our Adoption Center, with any offsite work needing approval from the Executive Director. Additionally, this is not a work-from-home position.

The Development Manager role is an exempt position, which requires a minimum of 8 hours per day, 40 hours per week and may include weekend, night, and holiday work. There is a possibility of receiving after-hour calls for emergencies, though not common.

There is no minimum period of employment guaranteed or implied by acceptance of an employment offer. It is the policy of Homeward Bound that all employment is at will.

- Salary range: \$48,000-\$55,000 per year, based on experience.
