### **Homeward Bound Cat Adoptions Saves Injured Young Cat, Seeks Community Support for Lifesaving Care**

**Las Vegas, NV** — A young cat named Lady Grey is recovering after a lifesaving surgery thanks to Homeward Bound Cat Adoptions. The organization is now asking for support to help cover the cost of her critical care.

Just weeks ago, a concerned couple brought Lady Grey to Homeward Bound after she was struck by a car. The approximately one-year-old cat, known in the neighborhood as a friendly outdoor companion, arrived with a severely shattered back leg and in significant pain.

“She was in critical condition,” said Vanessa Porter, Executive Director for Homeward Bound Cat Adoptions. “She didn’t have a chance without immediate intervention.”

Lady Grey was rushed to Tropicana Animal Hospital, where initial diagnostics revealed an additional complication: dangerously elevated liver values. This meant she couldn’t safely undergo anesthesia for surgery right away.

For several days, veterinary staff managed her pain, ensured she remained hydrated and nourished, and closely monitored her health until her body was strong enough to proceed.

Then, Lady Grey underwent a successful full leg amputation, a procedure necessary to give her a good quality of life. She remained under close observation for several days before being released into foster care.

Today, Lady Grey is happily recovering in a foster home. She enjoys gentle interaction, seeks out affection, and is beginning to display a renewed sense of trust and comfort.

“Foster care is a critical part of her recovery,” Porter shared. “It allows her to heal not just physically, but emotionally as well.”

However, the cost of Lady Grey’s care—including diagnostics, surgery, medications, and recovery—totals approximately \$2,700. As a nonprofit organization, Homeward Bound relies on community support. “We say yes to cats like Lady Grey because they deserve a chance,” Porter said. “But we can’t do it alone.”
